Transition Dates For Your Diary...

We are very much looking forward to meeting you and your child after the summer holidays, and have worked hard to create a transition plan that will enable your child to settle in at school. We are disappointed that we have not been able to meet you all before the summer, but please be assured that your child will still have the opportunity to transition smoothly into school with us here at Hinckley Parks. We appreciate your time during our recent telephone conversations and thank you for providing us with so much information about your child. We have also been in contact with key workers at nurseries and pre-schools to have gather additional information about your child.

Please see the detailed information below on how our transition process will work. If you have any questions regarding the transition please contact the school office before we break up for the summer holidays on **Friday 10th July**. There will also be the opportunity for you to book a 5-10 minute parent meeting with your child's class teacher if you wish to do so (see later table on how to book).

Starting on Wednesday **26th August 2020**, we will have our first Stay and Play session. **Parent/Carers must attend this session with their child.** Please look at your child's class teacher slip (included in this pack) to see the name of your child's class and teacher. You should **only attend the session relating to your child's class**. This will give you the opportunity to meet other parents and give your child their first opportunity to meet with their peers as well as their class teacher. Please enter school through the **Leicester Road gate** for these sessions. The class teachers will be there to meet you and direct you to the classrooms.

The following 2 days will involve your child attending for a morning or afternoon session on their own. If your child's **surname begins with letters A-M they are in Group A** and should only attend Group A sessions on Thursday 27th August and Friday 28th August.

If your child's **surname begins with N – Z they are in Group B**. and should only attend sessions relating to Group B on Thursday 27th August and Friday 28th August.

Please see the timetable below and your child's class teacher slip for clarity. For these sessions we ask that your child is dropped off and collected from their classroom door which will be pointed out to you during the stay and play session, due to take place on Wednesday 26th August.

You will need to enter via the Leicester Road gate for all afternoon sessions please.
