### HOMEWORK

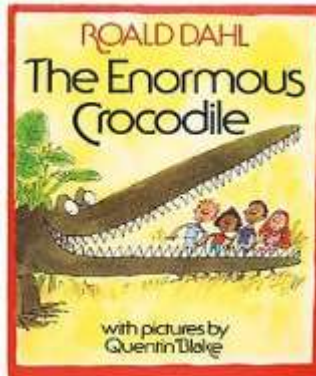
It is set every Friday & due in by the following Friday:
