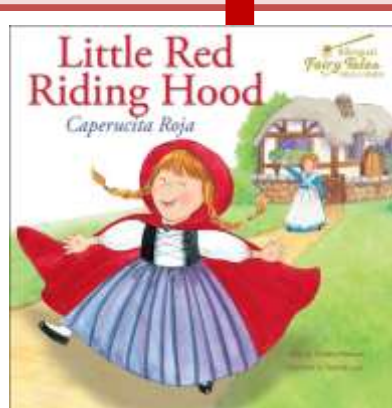
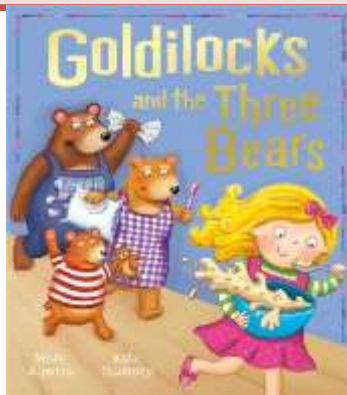


Our topic will be **Will You Read Me a story?**

LITERACY

Our key texts this term will focus on Traditional Tales.

- Use phonic knowledge to write simple words, labels and captions,
- Phase 3 Letters and Sounds, recognising familiar words and signs, segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together



EAD

Music: Our World, Everyone

Role play, constructs with a purpose in mind selecting a variety of resources, sings familiar songs, and plays cooperatively as part of a group to act out a narrative. Sings familiar songs, plays cooperatively as part of a group to act out a narrative

MATHEMATICS

We will continue our maths work using the Numberblocks approach. We will meet numberblocks 6-10, and begin to use all numbers 1-10 in addition and subtraction. We will begin to develop fluency with numbers 1-20 through counting forwards and backwards from different starting points. We will look at odd numbers and doubles to 5+5.

VALUES-BASED EDUCATION

Our focus values this term will be:

Integrity, courage, kindness, empathy.

Physical Development

The children will keep their PE kit at school every day. We will send these home at the end of each half term. We complete these activities throughout the week: Yoga, Mini Mile, Funky Feet , Daily Boost, Dough Disco,

READING

Reading tasks will include:

- reading and discussing our class texts;
- begins to read words in simple sentences, segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together, begin to read words in simple sentences, decode regular words and read them aloud
- reading a variety of books at home (for 10 minutes 3 x per week)

Please encourage your child to read regularly, and keep a record in their reading diary, particularly if an adult has heard them read. Your child will be benchmarked every half term.
