A formula for Success

Independent Learners are more successful learners.

How to be an Independent Learner

Readiness - Motivated:

Resourceful:

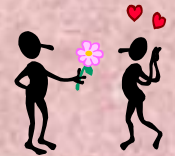
Use own skills, creativity, knowledge and resources around you, share ideas and learning, research more, be an active part of your group, collaborate, summarise, communicate effectively.

How to be an Independent Learner

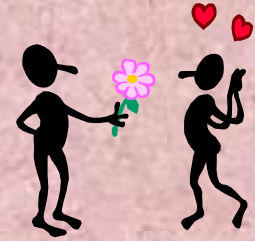
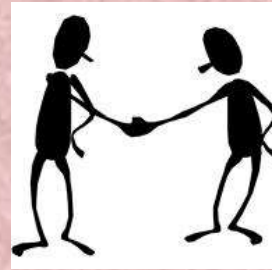
Reflective:
