We will be spending longer on each area of Maths in order to gain depth of understanding. We are covering:

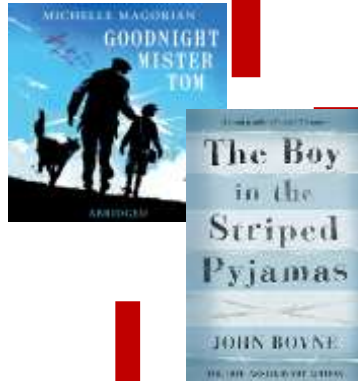
Place Value
